## **DISTRIBUTION OF RADIO BROADCASTING**

A total of 113 stations dot the radio broadcasting landscape in Nigeria today. This figure is accounted for by 44 federal government stations, 39 state government stations, and 30 private/commercial stations. They are distributed unevenly in different parts of the country.
